Greeting

1From the Elder, to the chosen Lady and her children, whom I truly love.^a And it's not just me that loves you—so does everybody who knows the truth. ^aBecause the truth has stayed with us,^b and it's going to be with us forever. ^aGrace, mercy, and peace are going to be with us in the presence of God our Father and in the presence of our Father's Son, Jesus Christ,^c in truth and love.

Truth and Love

⁴I was overjoyed to discover that some of your children are living^f in the truth, in line with the command we've received from the Father. ⁵And now, Lady, I'm asking you. It's not as though I'm writing a new command. Far from it—it's the one that we've had from the beginning: that we should love one another. ⁶And this is what love is: living^g in line with God's commands. This is exactly the command that you've heard from the beginning, that you're supposed to live^h in line with. ⁷Because lots of deceivers have gone out into the world—who don't acknowledge the physical nature of Jesus Christ's coming. ¹ That's the deceiver and the antichrist. ¹ ⁸Watch out for yourselves, so that you don't lose what you've achieved, and you get your full reward. ^k ⁹Everybody that goes off ahead, and doesn't stay with the teaching of Christ, doesn't have God. The person that stays with the teaching has both the Father and the Son. ¹⁰If somebody comes to you and doesn't bring this teaching, don't let them into your house, and don't say hello to them. ¹¹Because the person that says hello to them joins in their evil activities.
